


With two restaurants and two beautiful lounges to choose from, the Belmont Hotel gives diners plenty of choice for every occasion.



Dress Code: In the evening we have a preference for jacket & tie, but smart casual is accepted (no ripped denim, sportswear, beachwear or trainers).




RESIDENTS LOUNGE

All rooms benefit from private en-suite bathroom, satellite television, radio, telephone, free Wi-Fi and tea/coffee making facilities. Thanks to our fabulous location in three acres of private grounds, beside the sea and the town's cricket field, all rooms offer superb uninterrupted views.
