

## DINING OPTIONS


With two restaurants and two beautiful lounges to choose from, the Belmont Hotel gives diners plenty of choice for every occasion.


















# BELMONT SEA FACING ROOMS














# STANDARD DOUBLE


















# DELUXE SINGLE

# GENERAL INFORMATION

### ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

Rooms are available from 3.00pm on the day of arrival. On the day of departure please vacate your room by 11.00am.

#### **BEDROOMS**

Originally built in 1820 as a private Georgian residence, The Belmont Hotel has successfully retained all the original style and elegance of its heritage. While all rooms share the same high standards of comfort and design, all have their own individual character and charm. As you can see from our tariff, rates vary to reflect the size and aspect of each room category. All rooms benefit from private en-suite bathroom, satellite television, radio, telephone, free Wi-Fi and tea/coffee making facilities. Thanks to our fabulous location in three acres of private grounds, beside the sea and the town's cricket field, all rooms offer superb uninterrupted views.

### LAUNDRY

The hotel offers a laundry service for guests. Please give your laundry to your room attendant by 9.00am. An express dry cleaning service is also available. Shoe cleaning services are available at all times.

### FIRE SAFETY

The hotel is fitted with the latest fully addressable fire alarm systems. Please make yourself familiar with the fire exits and full fire emergency procedures, which are displayed in your room.

### **SMOKING POLICY**

The Belmont Hotel operates a non-smoking policy throughout all areas of our buildings, including e-cigarettes. Please note that smoking of cigarettes, e-cigarettes, pipes and cigars is only permitted in the designated areas outside of the hotel.

### THE BELMONT RESTAURANT

We have luxury Table d'hôte and À La Carte menus. Meals can also be taken at any other Brend Hotel by prior arrangement with the hotel receptions. Unfortunately, no allowance can be made for meals not taken. Drinks and light refreshments are available 24 hours a day.

Dress code: In the evening, we have a more formal dress code. We ask simply, as a courtesy to others, to respect an atmosphere that most guests prefer. (No ripped denim, sportswear, beachwear or trainers).

### HORIZON RESTAURANT

Our Horizon restaurant offers dining in a more informal atmosphere, yet still being able to enjoy the wonderful dishes that our Head Chef and his team create. Guests on dinner inclusive terms may dine from the Table d'hôte menu.

If you suffer from any form of food allergy, please discuss this with a member of staff who will be happy to advise our chefs to arrange your meals accordingly.

Please let the reception know if you have any disability or medical condition that could affect your health, safety and welfare during your stay.

#### WINDOWS & BALCONIES

Please be aware of the dangers of open windows and balconies. As part of the company's policy on health and safety all our bedroom windows have been fitted with restrictors. However, should you wish to have these removed during your stay please contact reception.

### MEDICAL SERVICES

In the interest of hygiene the Hotel does not accept dogs, with the exception of guide dogs and assistance dogs.
